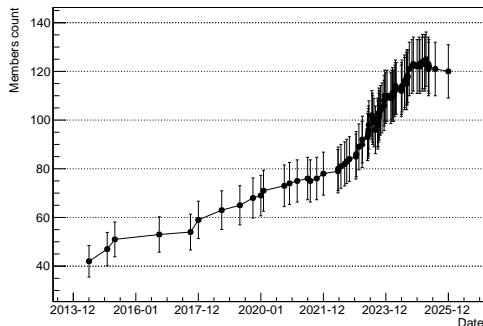

# Procedure for new personal members

For students/postdocs, membership is immediate, for researchers and institutes, the committee will discuss the application.

- Inform the Chair of Membership Committee, [grand-membership@in2p3.fr](mailto:grand-membership@in2p3.fr)
  - propose a collaboration subject
  - propose email lists to which the person should be added (software, hardware, analysis, layout)
  - write the email address of the candidate (if it is not the candidate writing)
- Join a working group
- Check accounts/access to GRAND tools/communications

If you are faculty, your contribution should be consulted with the groups chairs before the membership application!

# The membership fees

- For now, the membership in GRAND is free
- With expected constant running costs of GP300, a membership fee is expected to be introduced soon
- The fee is being determined based on the estimation of the running costs

# Changes since Nanjing meeting (2024)
